## OUR VALUES



Some of the values which are strongly encouraged among MFM members are:

**Passion for One.** The Christian story is about God's great love affair with man. We have the privilege of returning that love by living our lives in passionate devotion to Him.

**Never retreat from the enemies of the cross.** Some of the greatest victories in Scripture were won as resolute men and women of God stood their ground in the face of overwhelming opposition.

**Do all things with a heart of excellence.** One of our greatest privileges is to serve the Lord with the grace, dignity, and integrity befitting the King of kings.

**Liberty for all.** Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. Our greatest desire is for the Lord to dwell among us. II Corinthians 3:17 tells us that liberty in our midst proclaims His presence.

**Have the heart of a champion.** Our Christian heritage is filled with heroes of the faith like the Knights of the Cross, and biblical heroes like David and Joshua.

**Never leave a man on the field of battle.** We are committed to making every effort to recover our wounded and broken from the field of battle.

## ORGANIZATION of MFM

MFM is organized into two divisions or levels. This organizational structure not only helps our leadership team to understand their responsibility to each member, but it also assists individual members in recognizing their place of responsibility within the fellowship. We do not consider either division more or less important.

**Level One:** For those who are ordained through MorningStar, and who wish to make MFM their primary source of equipping and accountability. The MFM leadership team considers it their scriptural responsibility to know those members who labor among them. Most Level One members have been associated with MFM for at least one year.

**Level Two:** For ministers who are accountable to another church, movement, or denomination, but whose primary desire it is to partake of the fellowship, interchange, and personal ministry available through MFM.

MorningStar honors the integrity of local church government, and therefore it is our policy not to ordain members of other churches. We believe it is the responsibility of individual local churches, and their local leadership teams, to make decisions of that magnitude.



## MEMBERSHIP, BENEFITS, and FEES



MFM welcomes applicants from the ministries specified in Ephesians 4:11 and I Corinthians 12:28, as well as ministries which are implied and generally recognized by the church, such as intercessors and musicians.

All members receive subscriptions to the MorningStar Tape of the Month, Journal, and Prophetic Bulletin, as well as the MFM Quarterly Newsletter, which is designed and written exclusively for our members. In addition, MFM members receive a 20 percent discount on books, tapes, and videos published by MorningStar, and on MorningStar conference fees.

The greatest benefit of MFM, however, is the opportunity to connect with and work alongside like-minded brethren. Each year we schedule at least one retreat in order for members to build and strengthen relationships with our leadership team and with other members. Also, regional meetings, such as prophetic roundtables, are periodically conducted.

MFM has two levels of membership. Level One members, who are ordained through MorningStar, pay annual dues of \$350, while Level Two members, "Associates," are charged \$250. For members' spouses who desire to also be considered members, there is an additional fee of \$100 annually.
